

## MAPS Fall 2024 Aviation Merit Badge Campout Registration

*Dates and Times of the Event:* Sept 20<sup>th</sup>- 22nd. Friday arrival gates open and check-in begins at 4:00 PM. Sunday departure time is approximately 9:00 AM.

*General Description of the Event:* MAPS will host an Aviation Merit Badge Campout for Scouts BSA participants. Scouts will participate in (8) 40-minute classes on Saturday to complete the merit badge requirements.

*Special Attractions:* MAPS will create activity stations that provide an educational experience for Scouts BSA and meet the requirements associated with earning the Aviation Merit Badge. Space for tent camping will be provided onsite at MAPS for overnight campers. Troops are welcome but <u>not</u> required to camp overnight to participate in the Saturday classes.

*Admission Pricing:* Admission will be \$10 for each Scout. Two Adult leaders for each troop will be admitted free, with additional adults charged \$10 per adult. Pricing is the same whether you choose to overnight camp or not.

**Registration:** Attendance is limited for this event due to class size restrictions. Your registration will only be <u>confirmed</u> once I receive a completed registration form AND payment for expected attendees. I will send you a confirming email that you are officially registered after I receive your entry. MAPS does <u>not</u> refund payments for registered attendees who do not attend. I advise sending in a confident estimate of attendees with your payment. If space permits, you can request adding to your total attendees. If you don't have a firm headcount yet but are considering the event, send an email to Jim Felner (<u>felner.james@mapsairmuseum.org</u>), providing your Troop #, location, contact name, ph#, email, and estimated headcount so that I can place you on the "interested" list. Once you have a firm headcount estimate, send in the completed registration form and check to confirm your registration. Recognize that registration is first come, first served based upon when I receive a completed registration with payment.

*Other Comments:* Troops are required to supply their own food and snacks for the weekend. Plan to bring propane stoves to use for any hot meals. Portolets are provided in the camping area, plus restrooms are located inside the MAPS Hangar.
